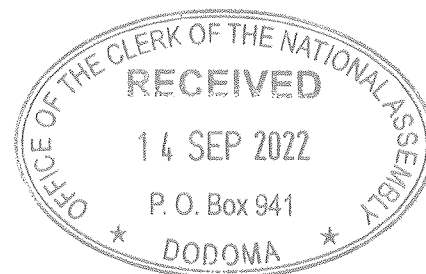


**SCHEDULE OF AMENDMENT TO BE MOVED BY THE HON. JUDGE
DR. ELIEZER MBUKI FELESHI (MP), THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AT
THE SECOND READING OF A BILL ENTITLED “THE WRITTEN LAWS
(MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) (NO. 2) ACT, 2022”**

(Made under S.O. 99 (10))

A Bill entitled “The Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Act, 2022” is amended as follows:

- A:** In Clause 4, by-
- (a) inserting the words “or to both” immediately after the words “ten years” appearing between the words “ten years” and “and substituting”;
 - (b) deleting the word “ten” appearing between the word “than” and “hundred” and substituting for it the word “one”;
- B:** In Clause 5 by inserting the words “or to both” immediately after the words “seven years” appearing between the words “seven years” and “and substituting”;
- C:** In Clause 6 by inserting the words “or to both” immediately after the words “twenty years” appearing between the words “twenty years” and “and substituting”;
- D:** In Clause 7 by inserting the words “or to both” immediately after the words “twenty years” appearing between the words “fifteen years” and “and substituting”;
- E:** In Clause 8, by inserting the words “or to both” immediately after the words “twenty years” appearing between the words “one year” and “and substituting”;
- F:** In Clause 11 by adding immediately after paragraph (d) the following:
- (e) inserting in their appropriate alphabetical order the following new definitions:
 - ““Commissioner General” means the Commissioner General of the Authority appointed under section 6 of the Act;
 - “officer in charge of police station” has the meaning ascribed to it under the Criminal Procedure Act;”;
- G:** In Clause 13-
- (a) in the proposed subsection (4), by inserting the phrase “upon approval by the Minister” between the words “may” and “establish”; and
 - (b) in the proposed subsection (5), by inserting the words “and rights” between the words “safety” and “of the person”;
- H:** In Clause 14, by-



(a) deleting the words "police" appearing in the opening phrase of the proposed section 32A (1);

(b) adding immediately after the proposed subsection (5) the following:

"(6) In case of emergency, the officer authorized to conduct search may exercise such powers in accordance with section 42 of the Criminal Procedure Act.";

I: In Clause 15 by adding immediately after paragraph (c) the following:

"(d) adding immediately after subsection (6) as amended the following:

"(7) For the purpose of this section, receipt includes form No. DCEA 003 prescribed in the Third Schedule.";

J: By deleting Clause 16 and substituting for it the following:

"Amendment of
Third Schedule

16. The principal Act is amended in the Third Schedule by adding immediately after form DCEA 003 the following:

"The Drug Control and Enforcement Act, CAP. 95

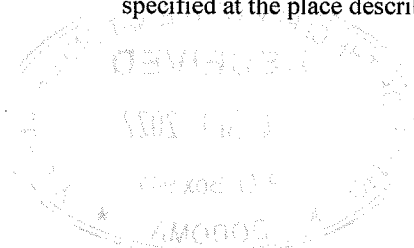
